

## Option 13 Analysis

Attached to this summary of Option 13 are:

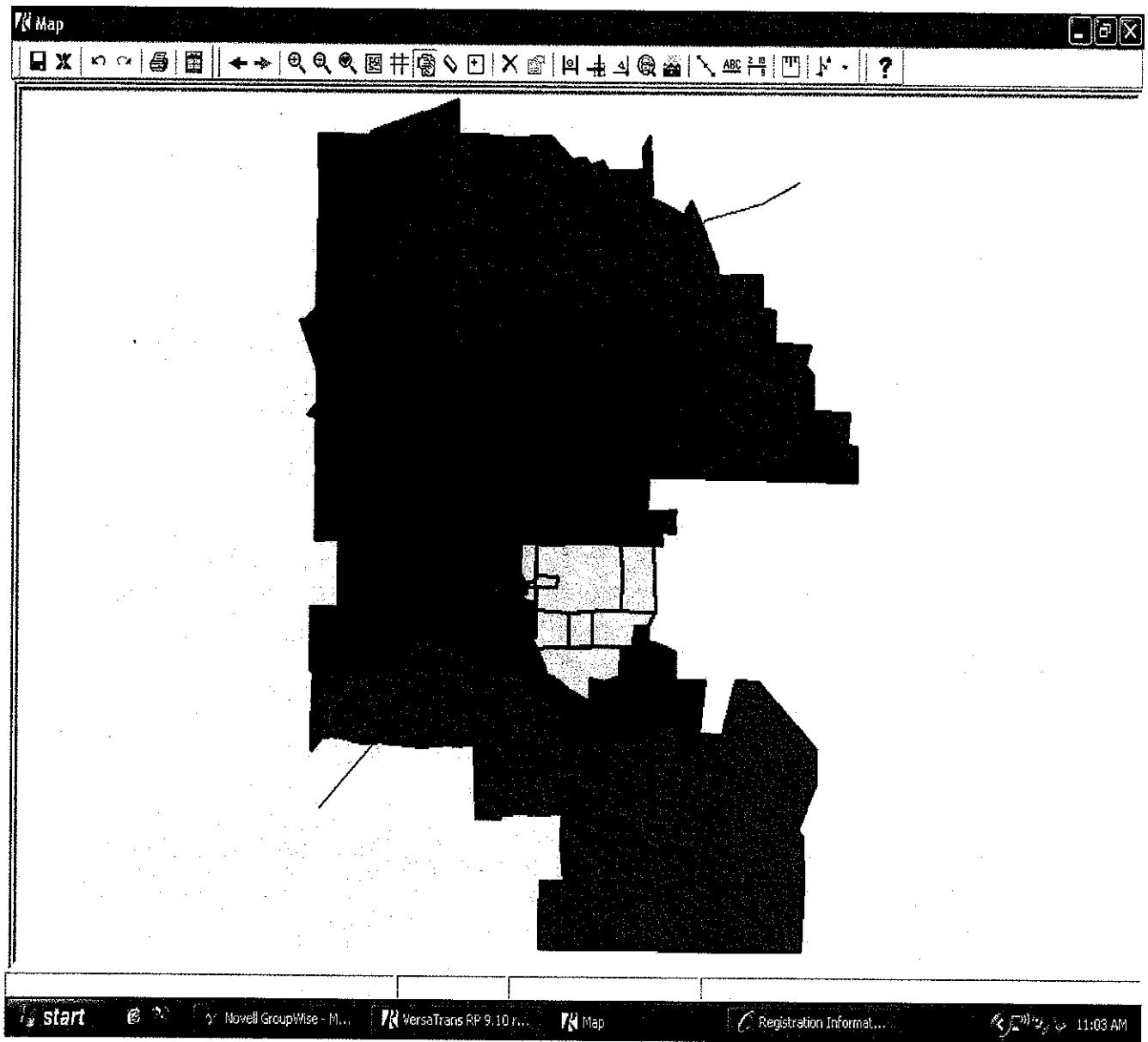

Summary of Strengths of Option 13:

- This option showed a slight improvement on Socio-Economic Balance from the current status with an improvement of 34.08% in standard deviation.
- While not quantified by projected specific transportation savings, there should be some savings based upon there being 66 more walkers than the other option recommended by the committee.
- This option displaced the fewest percentage of students of any of the final options considered, 11.26%
- The option was successful in keeping sub-divisions in-tact.
- This option scored high in maintaining our K-1 class size targets with average ranges from 19.3—20.9 per building. At the 2-5 levels the targets were also met with ranges from 22.6—24.7.
- No school exceeds the 600 student cap to avoid a mega school outcome. Isaac Fox (582) and May Whitney (585) are projected to have the largest enrollments.
- All schools except Isaac Fox (1) have at least two additional classrooms available. There is the option to move into available space at Middle School South if Isaac Fox should need additional classrooms beyond the one projected available classroom.

Summary of Weaknesses of Option 13:

- Students in the southern portion of the “C” are not attending their closest school geographically creating a leap frog aspect for over 200 students.
- Wicklow East and West are divided to separate schools from their current status of both attending Spencer Loomis.
- The visual impact of the boundary map is not pleasing because of the “C” extension into the southern portion of the district.

## Option 22 Analysis

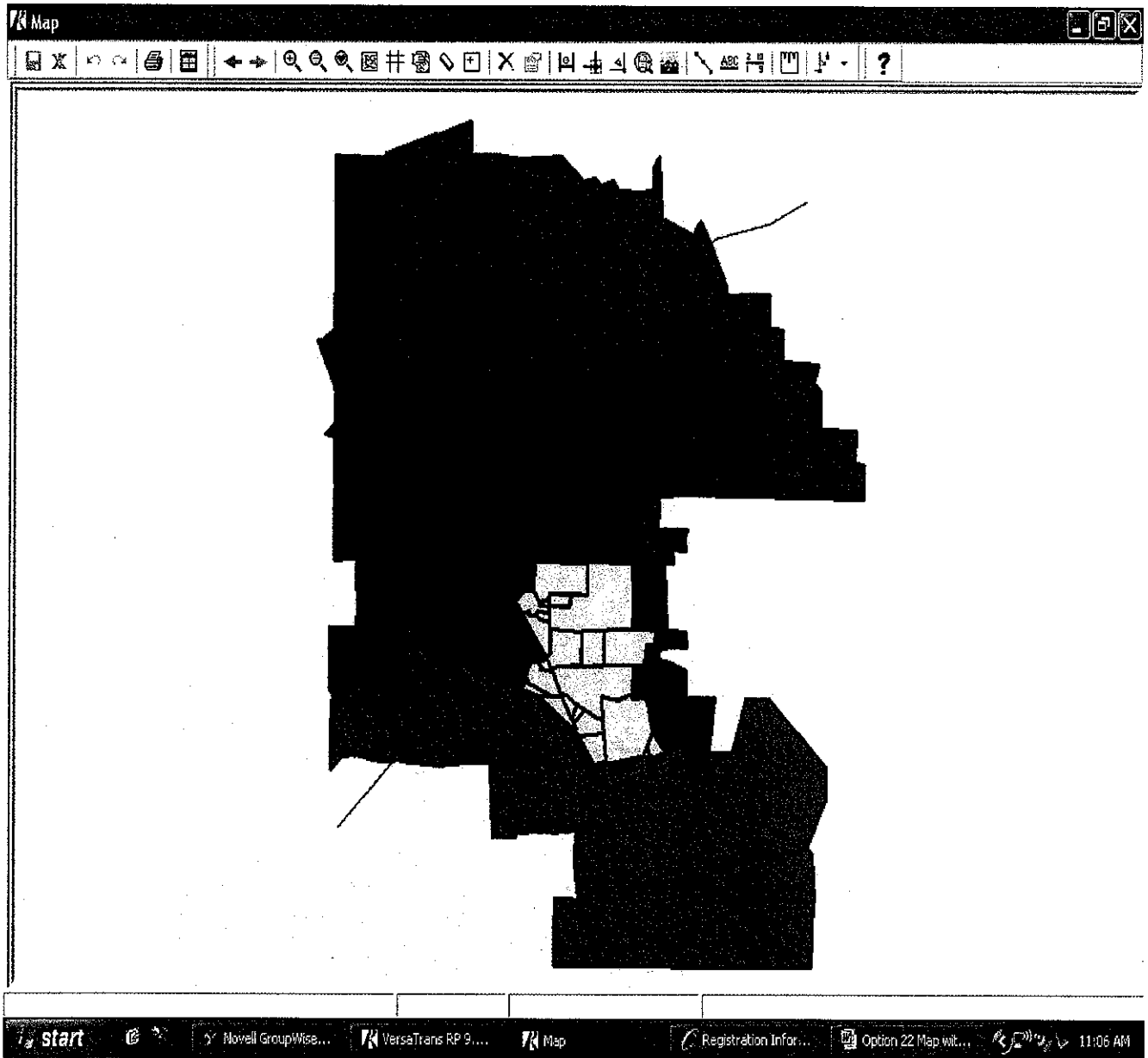

Summary of Strengths of Option 22:

- This option showed a slight improvement on Socio-Economic Balance from the current status with an improvement of 32.49% in standard deviation.
- Transportation costs should stay comparable to our current transportation costs and we can maintain the same targeted maximum bus ride of 40 minutes.
- This option scored well with displacement of students; 13.91% of non-Charles Quentin students are displaced on this option.
- This option was successful in keeping sub-divisions in place without splitting any.
- The option scored high in maintaining our K-1 class size target with average ranges from 19.3—22.0 per building. At the 2-5 levels the targets were also met with ranges from 21.3—24.6.
- No school exceeds the 600 student cap to avoid a mega school outcome. Isaac Fox (582) and May Whitney (583) are projected to have the largest enrollments.
- All schools except Isaac Fox (1) have at least two additional classrooms available. There is the option to move into available space at Middle School South if Isaac Fox should need additional classrooms beyond the one projected available classroom.
- The visual impression of the map is more easily understood.
- This option moves some of the current Sarah Adams population to May Whitney without breaking apart neighborhoods and provides for some Charles Quentin students to attend Sarah Adams.

Summary of Weaknesses of Option 22:

- There are 66 fewer walkers.
- Does not score quite as well on socio-economic balance as Option 13.
- Creates an 'island' perception in the southeast portion of the May Whitney boundary. The connection to the area is minimal even if it technically does not result in an absolute island. This results in some leap frog aspects to the boundaries.
- Wicklow East and West are divided to separate schools from their current status of both attending Spencer Loomis.
